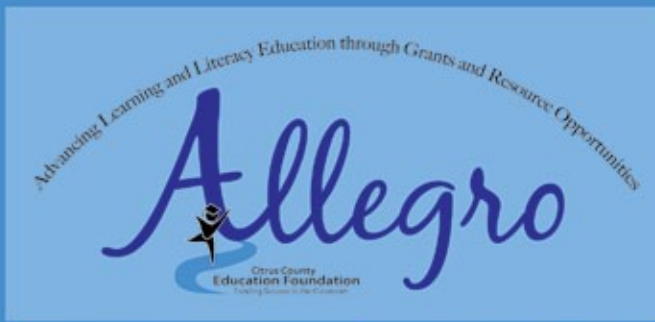

SWEET SPOTS

Plotting your personal Sweet Spot...

Matt Sullivan found some apps for that!

There are the two apps (one for iPad, iPod, and iPhone and the other for Android users) that show the formants, i.e. overtones, produced while singing in your sweet spot.

The more lines you produce bottom to top on the spectragraph, the more overtones you produce.
When you find the position with the most overtones you've found your sweet spot!!!
